Sir Syed Ahmed Khan (1817-1898) initially worked for East India Company as a jurist. After the 1857 independence was he published the Causes of Indian Mutiny (Risala asbaab) Founded Scientific Society of Aligarh. Denounced Congress for being pro-hindu and established Muslim League.

Sir Syed was criticized by ulema at the time for his approach towards religion.

1st phase 1947 - 1958

After the partition of India on the midnight of 14 and 15 August 1947 Pakistan followed the British system minister based at the prime minister secretariat. The Governor General of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam appointed Liaqat Ali Khan to establish and lead his administration on 15 Aug 1947. Before the presidential system in 1960, 7 prime ministers had served between 1947 until the establishment in 1958 by Ayub Khan Governor General of Pakistan.
