The Frame Hold options are designed to capture a still frame without creating any additional media or project item. The static freeze frame can be used for a variety of reasons.

Q4: What is jump frame?

Ans: A jump frame is a transition in which a video jumps from one frame to another, but smoothly and not abruptly. This shows some creativity and resourcefulness. Also this mostly use in music videos, and films. Jump frame is used to show video transition in other frames.

Q5: Mention 5 necessary Computer/Digital skills for a Journalist?

Q6: What is the function of a key frame?

Ans: In video editing, a key frame is a location on a timeline which marks the beginning or end of a transition. It holds special information that defines where a transition should start or stop. The intermediate frames are interpolated over time between those definitions to create the illusion of motion.

- **By sorting our media into bins or folders**. These folders can be given names and numbers as to avoid confusion during the editing process.
- Using different colors for quick identification. Color coding allows you to look at our timeline, then instantly know what goes where and what kind of footage we're dealing with.
- **Getting rid of useless stuff**. These may be clips or videos which are not required, but take up space in the bins.
- **Giving our track layers names**. These layers on our timeline are all labeled default names like "Video 1" or "Audio 1". We can change the labels if we want to keep specific clips on specific layers.

Q9: If you have a video recorded through your "Mobile Phone Camera" what will be the settings of your Project Sequence?

Ans: When you are starting a new project be sure to skip the "Choose settings". Now import your mobile phone video into the project window. Now start a new sequence (Ignore the sequence settings). As you do this now drag and drop any of your video into the sequence. At this stage adobe premiere pro will prompt you to change the sequence settings to match those of the video.

Q10: Through which transition you can "Fade Out" Audio of a clip in APP?

Ans: To fade in or fade out, you add a crossfade transition to either end of a single clip. Premiere Pro includes three types of crossfade: Constant Gain, Constant Power, and Exponential Fade. These are the standard ones which are used during the process of video editing.
