Ayub Khan was born on 14 May 1907 in Rehama a village in then North-west Frontier Province (Now Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Pakistan).

His family hailed from the Tareen tribe of Pashtuns.

He was the first child of the second wife of his dad, a Risaldar-major in the 9th Hodson's Horse which was a cavalry regiment of the British

India Army, for his basic education, he was enrolled in a school in Sarai Saleh, which was about 4 miles from his village. He used to go to school on a mules back and was shifted to a school in Haripur, where he started living with his grandmother.

He then went to study at Aligarh Muslim University (AMU) and while pursuing his college education, he was accepted into the Royal Military College at Sandhurst by the recommendation of general Andrew Skeem. He did not complete his degree and departed for Great Britain. Ayub Khan was
