### D panel Interview:

In a panel interview, typically three to size members having different roles in the organization ask candidates question to assess their knowledge, skills, ability to make decisions, etc.

For Example:

Armed forces recruitment  
admission interview, job interview.

2) One to one interview:-

In one to one interview, one person take the interview, it is an interaction between the interviewer and interviewee.

For example:

Job interview,  
counseling session, viva etc.

3) video-conference interview:-

Video-conference interview are becoming more common. They expand the scope of searching for qualified candidates with less cost and time involvement.  
For example,

National and multinational  
Jobs' recruitments.

#### 4) Presentation / demo interview :-

This type of interview requires presentation of already selected topics by interviewee in front of randomly assembled panel. Questions are asked in between the presentation as well as after the presentation. For example: class assignment, teachers' recruitment, marketing.

#### 5) Case Interview :-

In a case interview a candidate is given a problem to see how he or she would work it out on the spot and would manage the given problem. The problems that are presented come in many forms, but the interviewee want to assess the candidate's analytical skills, ability to
