Political Phase from 1947 to 1958:-

After the partition of India on the midnight of 14 and 15 Aug 1947 Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of prime minister.

Based at the Prime Minister Secretariat the Governor General of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam appointed Liaqat Ali Khan to establish and lead his administration on 15 Aug 1947. Before the Presidential system in 1960, 7 Prime Ministers had served b/w 1947 to 1958.
