⇒ It is the land mass of diversified relief with vast plains in the Indus basin, a rocky expanse of plateaus in the southwest and majestic mountains in the north with beautiful valleys, snow-covered peaks and glaciers.

Geography of Pakistan:

⇒ The Geography of Pakistan is a profound blend of landscapes varying from plains to desert, forest, and plateaus ranging from the coastal area of the Arabia sea in the south to the mountains of the Karakoram, Hindukush, Himalayas ranges in the north. Pakistan geologically overlaps both with the Indian and the Eurasian tectonic plates where the Sindh and Punjab provinces lie on the north-western corner of the Indian plate while Balochistan and most of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa lie within the Eurasia plate. Gilgit-Baltistan and Azad Kashmir lie along the edge of the Indian plate.

- Set up a journal, Tahzib-ul-Akhlaq, which contained articles of influential Muslims who agreed with Sir Syed's approach toward education.
- ~~✱~~ The Aligarh movement was the push to establish a modern system of education for the Muslim population of British India during the later decades of 19th century.

Sir Syed: Political Services For Muslims;

⇒ In the same year, Sir Syed founded the Muhammadan Association to promote political co-operation amongst Indian Muslims from different parts of the country. In ~~1868~~ 1886, he organized the All India Muhammadan Educational Conference in Aligarh, which promoted his vision of modern education and political unity for the Muslims.

// Political Phase 1 1947 to 1958.

⇒ After the Partition of India on the midnight of 14th and 15th August 1947 Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of Prime Minister. Based at the Prime Minister's Secretariat the Governor General of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam appointed Liaqat Ali Khan to establish and lead his establishment on 15th August 1947.

Before the presidential system in 1960, 7th Prime Minister had served between 1947 martial law in 1958 by Ayub Khan.
