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Q1. Write a detail note about Holy Quran.

Answer:

HOLY QURAN:

Holy Quran is the Holy book of Islam. The Quran was revealed by the angel Gabriel to the Prophet Muhammad (S.A.W). It is believed that Prophet Muhammad had received revelations from ALLAH for 23 Years. At first, these revelations were preached by the prophet verbally. Then the teachings of Muhammad (SAW) were set in the book. The Holy Quran is the most widely read book in the history of mankind, an inspiration, guidance and wisdom for millions of Muslims all over the world.

• Meaning of Word Quran:

The Holy Quran is the word of ALLAH (swt) revealed to Prophet Muhammad (SAW). As per sources the meaning of Quran is to collect as the word has been derived for "al-Qar". As second word is derived from "Qara" means "to recite". As ALLAH says in Quran to his people:

"A detailed exposition of every thing" (12:11)

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• Form and Content :

The Quran is subdivided into 114 Surah. The "Surahs" are subdivided into verses called "ayat". There are total 6,236 verses.

• Dignity Of Quran:

Quran act as practical guide in all affairs of Muslims like social, cultural, legal, economic & legal, political. Behavior and their limits are explained, mutual rights and responsibilities of men & women and children. The Quran act as a practical guide of life for Muslims

In Ayah 5 of Surah Al-Fatiha, man is told to ask ALLAH for the right path:

"Guide us Thou on the Right Path"

The Holy Quran says:

"Oh Mankind! Verily there has come to you a convincing proof from your lord for we have sent into you a light (that is manifest) (4:174)

• Definition of Quran:

The word plan can be put as ijtihads and fatwas produced under the light of Quran and hadiths in order to answer the new needs that arise in the growing building of Islam.

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ALLAH says:-

"And this is a book which we have revealed as a blessing: so follow it and be righteous, that they may receive mercy. (al-Anam, 6:155)"

• The words of Quran are Miracle:

The words of Quran in the shape of verses are in such form that nobody can claim to construct or make such words and it's a great miracle which has been announced by ALLAH in the Holy Quran. As Allah is the creator of All.

In the word of Quran there is a shifa for people.

Q2. According to Quran what is Tauheed and how it effect human lives?

• TAUHEED:

Tauheed is the most important Islamic belief. It implies that everything in existence originates from the one and only creator "ALLAH". It a belief on the fact that Allah is one and only one, and expresses his belief in words and actions.

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"It is true that tauheed is simply the oneness of Allah, yet the same time it is something which is so vividly explained in our religion, that is a life long quest for knowledge.

Holy Quran has made the creed on the oneness of Allah indispensable for Muslims. The Quran preaches about the oneness of Allah in very elegant form.

"Your God is one God: There is no god but he (Allah), the beneficent, the merciful." (Al-Baqarah: 163)

He believes in a Allah who is the creator of the heavens and the earth, the Master of East and west and sustainer of the entire universe. After this belief he doesnot regard anything in the world as a stranger to himself. He looks on everything that belongs to the one and only "Allah". His vision is enlarge. This belief produces in man the highest degree of self respect and self esteem.

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Q3. Write down explanation of Surah Quraish?

Ans. This is the 106 chapter in the Quran. Surah Quresh has four verses. This surah was revealed in Mecca.
