

Q Briefly describe the following

terms:-

* SOIL PIPES:-

Our soil & waste systems are manufactured in UK by Flo Plast in one of Europe's most technologically advanced factories. The result is high quality soil & waste pipes & fittings that are tough & durable.

* ANTI-SYPHON PIPES:-

The size of anti-siphon pipes merits careful consideration but no hard & fast rule can be laid down for a single fitting the sectional

area of the anti-siphonage pipe need not be much more than half that of the waste pipe. as a rule air, not by drain-air will therefore pass through the soil pipes & through the anti-siphonage pipes.

* SANITARY FIXTURES:-

Sanitary fixtures are installed in different areas. Bathbuds, washstands, showers, bungs, traps & bidets are installed in bathroom, washrooms & shower rooms. Toilet bowls, lavatory pans, and urinals of various types, washbasins equipped with flush tanks or taps are installed in lavatories.

* SANITARY TRAPSI-

A trap is a device which is used to prevent sewer gases from entering the building's. The traps are located below or within a plumbing fixture & retains small amount of water. The retaining water creates a water seal which stops foul gases going back to the building from drain pipes.

* CROSS CONNECTIONI-

A connection in a plumbing installation through which waste water may possibly pass to or come in contact with another part (as a water inlet in a bathtub that may at

limes be below the water
level of the tub.
