Explanation:-

In these verses Allah has described three characteristics of Momin or "The True believer". According to the verses a true believer will always believe in one true Allah he will never do Shirk. Shirk means believing in many gods, or believe in other god instead

of Allah. A True believer will never kill a human being with out any solid reason. For example, he will not kill people in greed or nor if he didn't like him. but he will kill Peoples in the way at Allah for religion for his independence. and The characteristic of a Momin is he will not commit illegal sexual intercourse. He will respect other woman's. So these are some characteristics which was mention in the verses.

Q3 Three

Translation:-

"O mankind! We have created you from a male and a female, and made you into nations and tribes, that you may know one another. verily, the most honorable of you with Allah is that (believer) who has Taqwa (Allah-consciousness, fearing from Allah). verily, Allah knows every thing All-Aware"
