Hajj:

- Hajj is one of five pillars of Islam.
- Hajj must be performed once in lifetime for those who are financially and healthy enough to do so.
- Hajj refers to an annual pilgrimage that Muslims embark on to Mecca and Saudi Arabia, with the intention of visiting the holy place and performing certain religious rites in accordance with the way prescribed by Prophet Muhammad S A W (Peace be upon him)
- The word Hajj means to “Attend a journey” which connotes both outward act of a journey and the inward act of intentions.
- The Hajj performed over five or six days, beginning on the eighth and ending on the thirteenth days of Dhu-ul-Hajj, the last month of the Islamic calendar.

- Completing Islam.
- Leaving wealth and family for the pleasure of Allah.
- Patience, under all circumstances.
- Praising Allah a lot.
- It is a show of submission and servitude.
- Cooperation for goodness against evil.

Q5, what is tawhid and prophethood in islam?

- **TAWHID:-**
- Tawhid is the most important Islamic belief.
