NAFL:-

WAJIB:-

This is also an obligatory prayer.

It has lesser importance than the fard prayer. The witr prayer (offered during the isha prayer) is a wajib prayer.

HAJJ:-

Hajj refers to the annual pilgrimage that Muslims embark on to Mecca in Saudi Arabia, with intention of visiting holy places and performing certain religious rites in accordance with the way prescribed by Prophet Muhammad (peace be upon him)

BENEFITS OF HAJJ:-

It is a ritual that is design to promote the bonds of Islamic brother hood and sister hood by showing that everyone is equal in the eyes of Allah.
