Prime Categories of prayer :

- Fard prayer
- wajib prayer
- Sunnah prayer
- Nafl prayer

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1) Nafil prayer :-

- > Nafil prayer are optional or voluntary prayer.
- > one can offer Nafil prayer depending on one's will.

Nafil - A voluntary act of worship. As Sunan al-Rawatib - The extra prayers done by the prophet before and after the daily obligatory prayers. Then if he has any extra prayers Allah would say: make up the deficiency in my servant's obligatory prayers with his supererogatory prayers.

2) Wajib prayer:

- > This is also an obligatory prayer
- > It has lesser important than the Fard prayer.
- > The witr prayer (offered during the Isha prayer) is a wajib prayer.
- Witr is an Islamic prayer (Salat) that is performed at night after Isha (night-time prayer) or before Fajr (dawn prayer). according to the Hanafi fiqh, witr prayer is wajib. The status of wajib is very close to that of Fard, therefore as little as one rakah can be prayed, and eleven at most.

Ans: Five Signs Before the day of Judgment:

1) The Arrival of Imam Mehdi :-

About the arrival of Imam Mehdi, the prophet (Saww) said the following lines 'One of my descendants created by Allah will come prior to the end of the world. His name ~~will~~ will be the same as mine and his father's name will be the same as my father's name. The world will be full of oppression and tyranny before his visit, but in his time will be fairness. The angel from the cloud from the above his head will say, 'This is Mehdi, listen to what ^{he} say'. He will fight against different enemies of Islam and develop the system of justice around the world.

2) Dajjal will come :-

The most obvious and common signs that most people are told as the arrival of Dajjal.

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When he will arrive, he will proclaim himself as God. Any one who trusts him will be an infidel. The question arises why would people trust him when they are being guided about him? Here the fitnah of Dajjal works where the mindsets of the population are set in a way that would automatically accept the fact that he is God (God forbid). Dajjal will have power that he could order the clouds to rain and the earth to grow vegetation. These powers will make people believe he is God. Which in reality would be false signals.

2) The Descent of Jesus:

When Dajjal has arrived and he is claiming to be God, the descent of prophet Jesus will happen. He would then fight with Dajjal and kill him. Also he will destroy the cross, rescue muslim from the Ya'jooj and Ma'jooj and take them to the mountain of Tur.

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4) The fire will begin:

Another major sign of the Day of Judgment is the eruption of fire from the direction of Yemen, from the bottom of 'Aden, from the Sea of Hadramaut. According to Hudhayfah ibn Usayd, the prophet (Saww) was heard saying 'The last of them will be a fire which will emerge from Yemen, and will drive the people to the place of their gathering.

5) The Sun will rise from the west:

One of the major signs of Dayamah is the rising of the Sun from the west, which is its setting place. Narrated by Abu Hurayrah, the prophet (Saww) said: 'The Hour will not come until the Sun has risen from the west, and when it rises and people see it, they will all believe, but that will be when it will do a person no good to believe, if he ~~had~~ believed not before, nor earned good (by performing deeds of righteousness) through his faith.
