- ⇒ Nafl prayer.

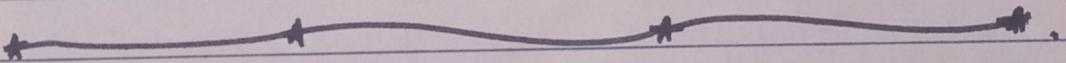
## Difference b/w nafl and wajib prayer:
