Ans:- educational services:- for educational
sir syed Ahmad Khan is best known for the
Aligarh Movement a systemic movement
aimed at reforming the social, political
and educational aspect of the Muslim
community. He founded the scientific society
in 1863 to translate major works in
the sciences and modern arts
into Urdu. He released two journals
to this end The Aligarh Institute
Gazette, which was an organ of the
scientific society, and the Tuhzibul
Atchlag, known as the Muhammedan
social Reformer in English.
But Khan most notable contribution
to the field of education is
establishing the Madarsatul Uloom
in Aligarh in 1875, now known as

the Aligarh Muslim University, a premier educational institution of the country. He attempted model the college on universities such as Oxford and Cambridge. His work on Muslim education was not limited to this alone he wanted to create a network of educational institutions managed by Muslims and founded the All India Muslim Educational Conference.

Political services:- For political services the political career of Syed Ahmed Khan began after 1857. He provided political leadership by uniting the people under a banner of Islam. He wrote various notable works in order to remove the mistrust of the Britishers towards the Muslims. He favored separate electorate for the Muslims in 1883 saying that the majority would override the interests of the minority.
