\* NAFL PRAYER:

In Islam, a nafl Prayer or supererogatory Prayer is a type of optional Muslim Salah. As with Sunnah Prayer, they are not considered obligatory but are thought to confer extra benefit on the person performing them. An example is offering of 4 "nafl" rakat before the compulsory dhuhur Prayer.

Nafl prayer are optional or voluntary prayer.

one can offer prayers depending on one's will.

## → WAJIB PRAYER:

\* Witr Wajib is an Islamic prayer that is performed at night after Isha prayer.

\* This is also obligatory prayer.

\* It has lesser importance than the fard prayer.

\* The prayers and Eid's mean's eid-ul-Fitr and eid-ul-Ada are Wajib prayers.
