The sunset prayer it is three Rakat salah.

③ Isha :-

The night prayer
it is four Rakat Salah.

It takes place during Dhul Hijjah which is final month of Islamic calendar.

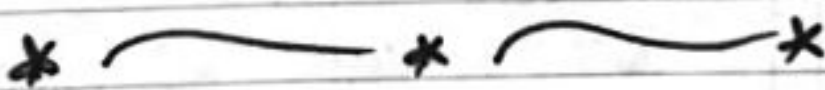
This years of millions of Muslims from across the world are making the journey to Mecca from 9 to 14 August.

- ② Travel to Mina.

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- ③ Travel to mount al-Arafat to perform wata'iq.
- ④ Offer prayers in Muzdalifah.
- ⑤ Perform Rami in Mina.
- ⑥ Animal sacrifice Nahr.
- ⑦ Halq (shaving the head) or Tazim.
- ⑧ Clipping or shortening of the hair for men and women.
