. UPPER LIMB

The upper limb has a wide range of precise movements associated with it to allow us to effectively interact with our environment the 6 main joints covered here from proximal to distal are the sternoclavicular acromioclavicular shoulder elbow radioulnar and wrist joints.

. JOINTS OF UPPER LIMB.

The joints of free upper limb (articulation of the upper extremity except the shoulder girdle) are:

.FUNCTIONS OF UPPER LIMB.

An extremity or appendage that is distinct from the head and trunk an arm ,leg flipper or wing.limbs for locomotion, such as walking running, flying, climbing, swimming. some use their front and manipulate objects.

This occur between the rounded head of the humerous and the shallow pear shaped glenoid cavity of the scapula.

The glenoid cavity is deepened by the presence of atibrocartiligious rim called the glenoid labrum.
