" when a delegation from tribes of tamim comes to holy Prophet (SAW) Abubakar (RA) suggested to the Holy Prophet al Qa'qa ibn Mabad (RA) be sent to meet them and umar ibn khatab (RA) said that Al aqra bn qays (RA) be sent instead. Abu bakar (RA) was irritated by Hazrat Umar (RA)'s counter proposal so he turned to Umar (RA).

• "you only said that to contracted me. Umar RA returned and replied that he did not do to be country, A quarrel aroused an both of them

raise their voices to such a level that the Prophet (SAW) voice was drowned out.

<u>ANSWER</u> NO 2:

TRANSLATION:

"And those who invoke not any other god along with Allah , nor kill such life as Allah has forbidden nor commit illegal sexual intercourse and whoever does this shall receive the punishment"

EXPLANATION:

In this verse Allah has described three characteristics of true believers

- Who invoke not any other god along with Allah one kill such life as Allah has forbidden except for just cause
- Nor commit sexual intercourse.

PREVENTION FROM SHIRK:

" And those who invoke not any other god along with Allah"

In this ayah the description that Allah gives his true servants is that they do not call on any other illah besides him recall how we said that in illah is anything that fell your heart in you illah is what is always on your mind you will naturally have hope in your illah to save you from troubles and deficulties so you put all your hopes in youir illah and you call on your illah all the time describes his true servents in this ayat is those who do not call on any other illah besides Allah. Translation:
