	ANS	<p><b>A) <u>ANOLOGOUS COLOR SCHEME:-</u></b></p> <p>The group of three colors that are next to each other on color wheel is called analogous color scheme. It uses one base color and two secondary colors placed symmetrically around it on color wheel. In this the base color use as a main color while the secondary colors are use for the highlighting.
