a visual image together and also by rhythm.

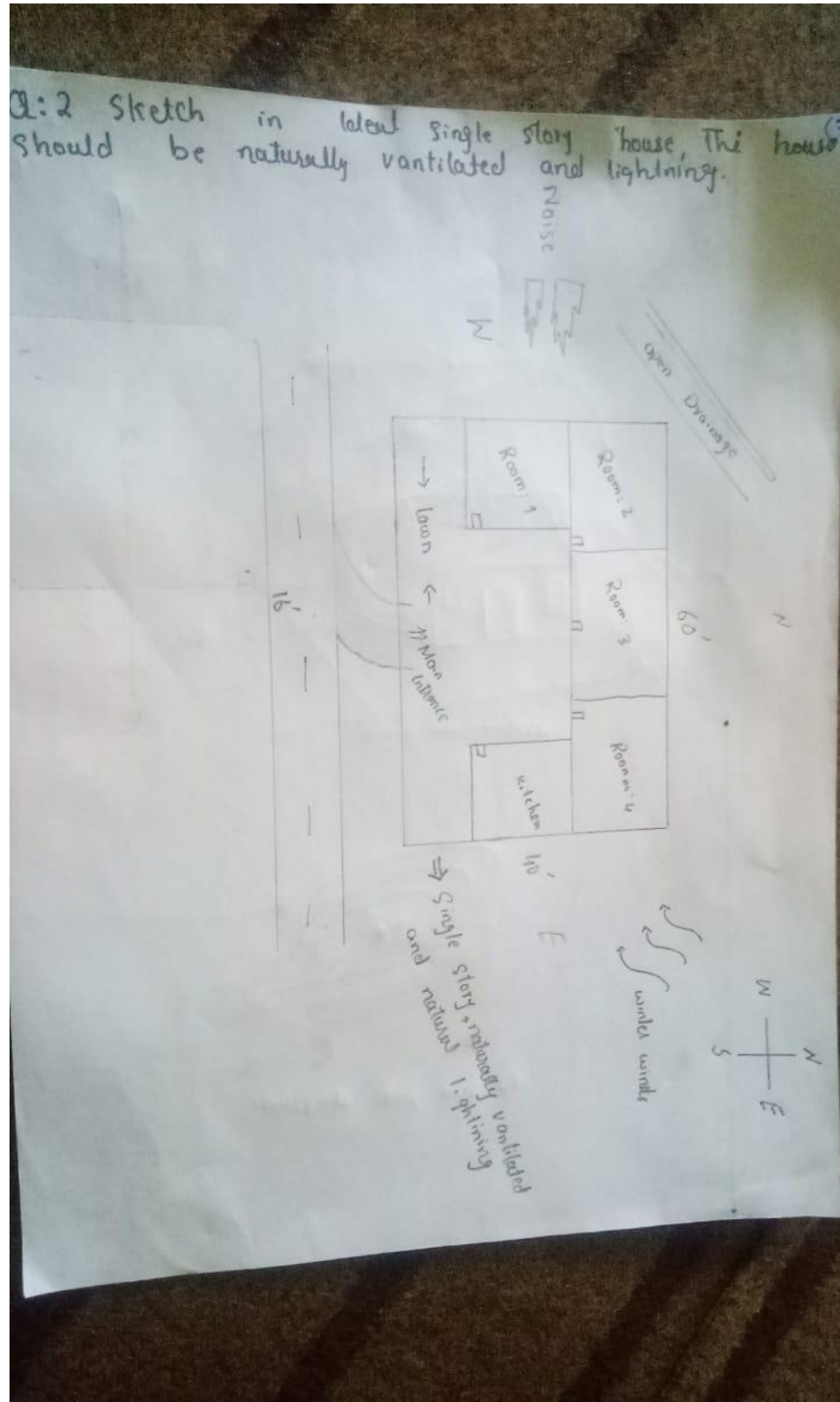
Emphasis: The bridge b/w the twin towers is very
