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**Answer No. 1:-**

***Sir Syed Educational and Political Service for Muslims:-***

**Educational Service:-**

Sir Syed Ahmad Khan served the Muslim in every aspect. He was the first Muslim who realized the importance of education for his people. He wanted his nation to seek knowledge and become the equal citizen.

In order of equip the Muslim with the ornament of knowledge he opened the following educational institutions and different societies which revolutioned the life of Muslims of community.

- (a) Two Madrassahs in Moradabad 1858 and Ghaziabad 1862 were opened which imparted education in Persian.
- (b) In 1864, Sir Syed Ahmed Khan laid the foundation of scientific society which translated English works into Urdu.
- (c) M.A.D High school Aligarh was founded in 1875.

In 1877 M.A.D High school was given the status of a college and inaugurated by Viceroy Lord Lytten. Later on, this college become a university in 1920 A.D

## **Political Service:-**

### **1. Advice to Students:-**

Sir Syed advice to Muslim in the political field is also important. He believed that under the European system or democratic government the Muslim of India would always be at the mercy of Hindu majority. He suggested separate electorate for Muslims. He advice the Muslim not to join Congress.

### **2. Urdu-Hindi Controversy:-**

In 1867 Hindus demanded that Hindi should be made on official language of India in place of Urdu. They started an agitation. The Hindus were against Urdu because it was the language of Muslims. Sir Syed convinced that the Hindus would never be friend the Muslims. Due to this reason sir Syed starts Two Nation Theory telling that Muslims and Hindus were two separate kinds of people. Muslims opposed this and supported Urdu as it was the sign and united the Muslims of India under one language.

After the partition of India on the midnight of 14 and 15 August, 1947.

Governor General of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam appointed Liaquat Ali Khan to establish and lead his administration on 15 Aug, 1947.
