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HOLY BOOK QURAN :-

It is believed that prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) had received revelations from Allah for 23 years. At first these revelations were preached by the Prophet verbally. Later Muhammad's teachings were set down in a book called the Quran. After Muhammad's death all teachings of Muhammad (S.A.W) were compiled under the direction of the first Sunni Caliph Abubakr. The work was completed about 1400 years ago.

EXPLANATION:-

The Holy book Quran is composed of 114 verses or surahs of varying lengths, the Quran covers a wide range of subjects. It puts a special emphasis on the concept of oneness of

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of god and his concern about the spiritual and worldly welfare of man. The Holy scripture also enlightens on the creation of the world, specially of man, of good and evil spirits, man's responsibility for his actions, the day of judgment, the final account, the rewards and punishments.

SUPERIORITY :-

The Holy Quran is superior to all the Holy books in many respects, as for instance.

⇒ Each and every word of this Holy Book is preserved in its original form. Not even a dot has been removed or cancelled. Nor will there be any changes in it till the day of judgment.

IMPORTANCE OF LANGUAGE :-

The language of the Holy Quran is a miracle.

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The style is so incomparably sublime that it is beyond human faculty to compose even anything like the smallest part of it in beauty.

DIVINE CODE :-

The Holy Quran has brought the final Divine code. Hence, a number of injunctions supercede those in the earlier Holy Books.

REVELATION :-

The previous Holy books were revealed all at once, but the revelation of The Holy Quran continued in twenty-three years, bit by bit as when necessity arose.

MODERATE LAWS AND TANETS :-

The tanets and laws of the Holy Quran are so moderate that they suit all times.

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VERSES AND HADITHS ABOUT IMPORTANCE OF HOLY QURAN:-

The importance of Quran are stated as follows in verses and hadiths.

VERSE:-

"The Quran is guidance and glad tidings for those who believe".

HADITH:-

"If a person reads a verse from the book of Allah, it will be a luminous light for him on the Day of Judgment".

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SURAH QURAISH:-

This surah was revealed in Makkah. Quraish is the name of an Arab tribe that used to be scattered across Arabia until a man named Qussay gathered them together in Makkah and they eventually gained control of the Kaba.

While most Arabian tribes were constantly at battle with each other, the Quraish had an advantage because they were the controllers of Kaba. As such they were very respected.

REVEALATION PERIOD:-

This surah was revealed between 610 and 615 AD.

ASBAB AL NUZUL:-

This surah was revealed in Makkah most probably during the early days of

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Muhammad's (SAW) proclamation of his prophet hood.

⇒ This surah gives a brief account of God's Blessings on the tribe Quraish where Muhammad (S.A.W) was born.

⇒ The word Ilaf in original is from alf which means to be habituated and accustomed to be reunited after breaking up and to adopt something as a habit.

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TRANSLATION:-

"Since the Quraish became accustomed, accustomed to the journey of winter and summer, therefore let them worship the Lord of this house who had fed them against hunger, and secured them against fear".

VIRTUE OF STUDYING SURAH QURAISH :-

On the virtue of reciting the surah, a tradition is adequate to cite from the Holy prophet who has been narrated to have said;

"He who recites it is rewarded ten good deeds as many as the number of those who perform the ritual circumambulation of the Kaba and spiritual retreat in the sacred Mosque".

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TAUHEED :-

Tauheed is an Arabic word which means attributing oneness to Allah and describing him as being one and unique with no partner or peer in his essence and attributes.

⇒ The Arab say waahid, ahad and waheed, all meaning one. Allah is wahid, meaning that he has no rivals or peers in any way.

⇒ One who does not believe in tauheed is not a momin.

HOLY VERSES ON TAUHEED :-

Some of the Holy verses on Tauheed are following :-

1. "And I (Allah) created not the Jinn and mankind except that they should worshipping me (Alone)."

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2. "And your Lord has decreed that you worship none but him".

3. "Say, Allah is the creator of All things and he is one, the Almighty".

4. "Allah is the creator of all things and he is guardian over all things".

EXPLANATION:-

The Quran contains guidance for muslims on the nature of Allah and how to live a good life that pleases Allah.

⇒ Allah witnessed that there is no deity except him, and (so do) the angels and those of knowledge (that he is) maintaining the creation in justice. There is no deity except him, the exalted, in ~~the~~ might, the wise.

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EFFECT OF TAUHEED ON HUMAN LIFE :-

The effects of tauheed on human lives are as follows :-

- ⇒ A believer in this testimony can never be narrow in outlook.
- ⇒ This belief produces in man the highest degree of self respect and self esteem.
- ⇒ This belief generates in a man a sense of modesty and humbleness. It makes him unostentatious and unpretending.
- ⇒ This belief makes man virtuous and upright.
- ⇒ The believer never becomes despondent.
- ⇒ The testimony of faith inspires bravery in a man.
