## Political and Constitutional phase

1st 1947 to 1958

⇒ After the partition of India on the mid-night of 14<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> August 1947 Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of Prime Minister based at the Prime Minister Secretariat. The governor general of Pakistan Quid-e-Azam appointed Liaquat Ali Khan established and lead his administration on 15 August. Before the presidential system in 1960 at 7 PM (Prime Minister) had served by 1947 until Marsh Law 1958.
