Objectives of Zakat

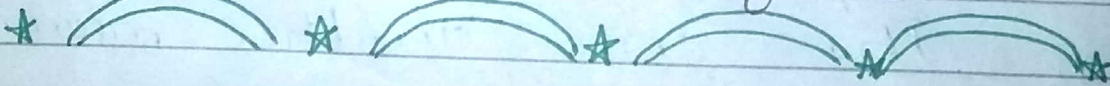
(*) To control concentration of wealth

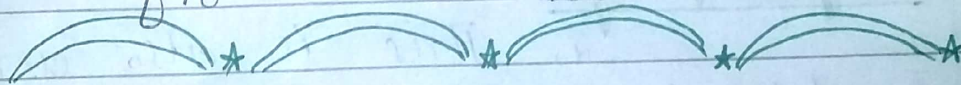

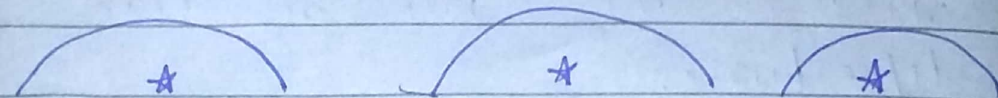
