Sir Syed educational services:-

Sir Syed Ahmad khan was the first Muslim leader who realized the importance of education for his people. In the order of equip the Muslim with the ornament of knowledge he opened the following educational institutions and societies which revolutioned the life of Muslim community.

- 1. Two madrassahs in Muradabad(1858) and Ghaziabad (1862) were opened which imparted education in Persian.
- 2. In 1864 sir Syed Ahmad laid the foundation of scientific society which translated English works into Urdu.
- 3. M.A.D high school Aligarh was founded in 1875.
- 4. In 1877 M.A.D high school was given the status of a college and inaugurated by viceroy Lord Lytton later on, this college became university in 1920 A.D.
- Two nation theory:-

Sir Syed Ahmad khan is regarded as one of the greatest exponent of "Two nations theory" because after the Hindi-Urdu controversy he was convinced that Hindu were not sincere towards the Muslims. Answering a query of Mr. Shakespeare, commissioner of Benares, he remarked "Now I'm convinced that both these communities will not join whole-heartly in anything. At present there was no open hostility between the two communities, but on account of the so-called educated people it will increase immensely in future.

Ans#2:

• 1st phase 1947 to 1958:-

After the partition of India on the midnight of 14 and 15 August 1947, Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of prime minister:

Based at the prime minister's secretrate, the governor general of Pakistan Quaide-Azam appointed Liaqat Ali khan to establish and lead his administration on 15 August 1947. Before the presidential system in 1960 "7" prime minister had served between 1947 untill Marshal law in 1958 by Ayub Khan.

Geography of Pakistan:-

Pakistan is located in South Asian it forms the northwest of subcontinent of indopakistan. It lies between the latitude of 23,31 and 36,45 north and between the longitude of 61, 75 and 31 east.
