Ans. 1st phase 1947 to 1958

⇒ After the partition of India on the midnight of 14 and 15 August 1947 Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of prime minister. Based on the prime ministerial system the governor general of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam appointed Liaquat Ali Khan to establish and lead his administration on 15 August 1947. Before the presidential system in 1960. (7) prime minister had served between 1947 until Mirza Buzurg in 1958 by Ayub Khan.

=> Having a predominately indo-iranian speaking population.

=> Pakistan has historically and culturally been associated with its neighbours Iran, Afghanistan, and India, achieved independence in 1947.

Pakistan has been distinguished from its larger southern neighbour by its overwhelmingly.

The East wing, or East Pakistan, became the independent state of Bangladesh in December 1971.

=> Pakistan occupies a position of great geographic importance, bordered by Iran and on the west Afghanistan on the north west China on the northeast, India on the east, and the Arabian Sea on the south.

=> The total land area is estimated at 803,940 square kilometer.

=> The boundary with Iran some kilometer in length, was first delimited by a British commission in 1893, separating Iran from what was then British Indian Balochistan. In 1957 Pakistan signed a frontier agreement with Iran, and since then the border between has not been a subject of serious dispute.

=> Pakistan's boundary with Afghanistan is about 2,250 kilometer long.

=> In the northernmost tip the country control about 84,159 square kilometer. This area consisting of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (11,639) square kilometer and the most of the Northern Areas. Jammu and Kashmir.
