Q.1 Explain the importance of ideology in national life?

Ans. An **ideology** is a collection of ideas or beliefs shared by a group of people. It may be a connected set of ideas, or a style of thought, or a world-view. ... Communism, socialism, and capitalism are political/economical **ideologies**. Many political parties base their political action and program on an **ideology**.

Ideologies are patterned clusters of normatively imbued ideas and concepts, including particular representations of power relations. These conceptual maps help people navigate the complexity of their political universe and carry claims to social truth.

Q.2 Describe the services of render by sir syed ahmad khan for for the cause of indian muslims?

Ans. **Ahmed Khan** (born 3 June 1974) is an Indian choreographer, producer, director and writer. He has choreographed several films after a brief acting stage, and has moved onto writing, producing, and directing other Bollywood films.

Sir Syed intensified his work to promote co-operation with British authorities, promoting loyalty to the Empire amongst Indian Muslims. Committed to working for the upliftment of Muslims, **Sir Syed** founded a modern madrassa in Muradabad in 1859; this was one of the first religious schools to impart scientific education.

Sir Syed played a vital role in the educational uplift of the **Muslims in India**. He did the following things to improve the educational standards: set up a journal, Tahzib-ul-Akhlaq, which contained articles of influential **Muslims** who agreed with **Sir Syed's** approach towards education. It asserted that "a Muslim of one country has far more sympathies with a Muslim living in another country than with a non-Muslim living in the same country."

Q.3. Write any five basic points of ideology of Pakistan.

Ans. The two-nation theory advocated by the All India Muslim League is the founding principle of the **Pakistan** Movement (i.e. the **ideology of Pakistan** as a Muslim nation-state in the northwestern and eastern regions of India) through the partition of India in 1947.

As societies changed throughout history, so did the **ideologies** that justified systems of inequality. Sociological **examples of ideologies** include: racism; sexism; heterosexism; ableism; and ethnocentrism

In social studies, a political **ideology** is a certain ethical set of ideals, principles, doctrines, myths, or symbols of a social movement, institution, class, or large group that explains how society should work, offering **some** political and cultural blueprint for a certain social order.
