→ Meaning of Zakat:-

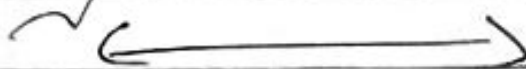
There are two (2) meanings of Zakat.

Prime Categories of Prayers:-

Prayers is a religious service, specially a regular one, at which people gather in order to pray together.

• Prayers is the second pillar of Islam. It is a prescribed liturgy five times a day and oriented towards Mecca.

- i) Fard prayer.
- ii) Wajib prayer.
- iii) Sunnah prayer.
- iv) Nafil prayer.

① Fard prayer:-

→ Fard prayers are compulsory.
→ If it is missed for some reason, it should be made up later.

ii) Wajib prayers:-

→ This is also an obligatory prayer.

→ It has lesser importance than Fard prayer.

→ The witr prayer is a wajib prayer.

iii) Sunnah prayers:-

→ It was the practice of the Prophet ~~AM~~ Muhammad (PBUH)

→ Allah did not command to perform this prayer.

iv) Nafil prayers:-

→ These are optional or voluntary prayers.

→ One can offer prayer on depending on one's will.

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→ Difference between Nafl and wajib prayers:-

The difference between wajib and Nafl prayers are that wajib prayers is an obligatory prayer while Nafl prayers are optional or voluntary prayers.

• Nafl prayers are prayed on one's will while witr (offered during the isha prayer) is a wajib prayer

→ Leaving wealth and family for the pleasure of Allah.

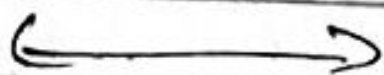
→ Patience, under all circumstances.
