First phase (1947-1958)

After the partition of India on midnight of 14 and 15 August 1947 Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of prime minister.

On the basis of prime minister's secretariat the Governor General of Pakistan Quid-e-Azam ~~is~~ he established and lead the Iqbal-Ali-Khan on 15 August 1947 before the presidential system in Pakistan in 1960. 7 prime ministers served b/w 1947 until martial law in 1958-1971 by Ayub Khan.

Pakistan is located in South Asia. It forms North West of Subcontinent of India Pakistan. It lies in latitude of 23, 31, 36, and 45° and longitude of 61, 75 and 91° East.

Pakistan is bounded in East by India and West by Iran and Pakistan is bounded North by Afghanistan. It is also called Durand line. Pakistan border with India is 1610 km and Pakistan border with China is 585 km and Pakistan border with Afghanistan is 2758 km.
