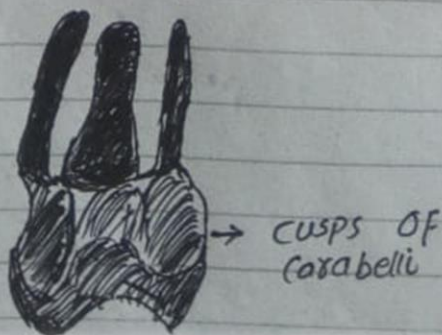

Palatal Aspect Of 1st Maxillary Molars:-

- Ans :-
- => Outlines Reversed from the buccal aspects stills trapezoidal.
 - => mesiopalatal largest cusps.
 - => Disto palatal smallest cusps, almost spheroidal.
 - => Has a palatal pit at the end of distopalatal groove.
 - => There may be a cusps on the palatal surface of the mesiopalatal cusps.
 - => This is a fifth cusps called the cusps of Carabelli, which is visible in addition to the four cusps on the occlusal surface

=> Geometrical Outline Of Mandibular And Pre-molars

=> Geometrical Outline also occurs in the mesial aspect of mandibular and Pre-molars.

=> it is rhomboid in shape due to the lingual inclination.

=> The outline is also convex from the cervical line to the cusps tips

=> The lingual Outline is convex

=> Just as we know that the geometrical Outline used for what purpose.

=> The main purpose of the geometrical Outline is to give significant tooth
