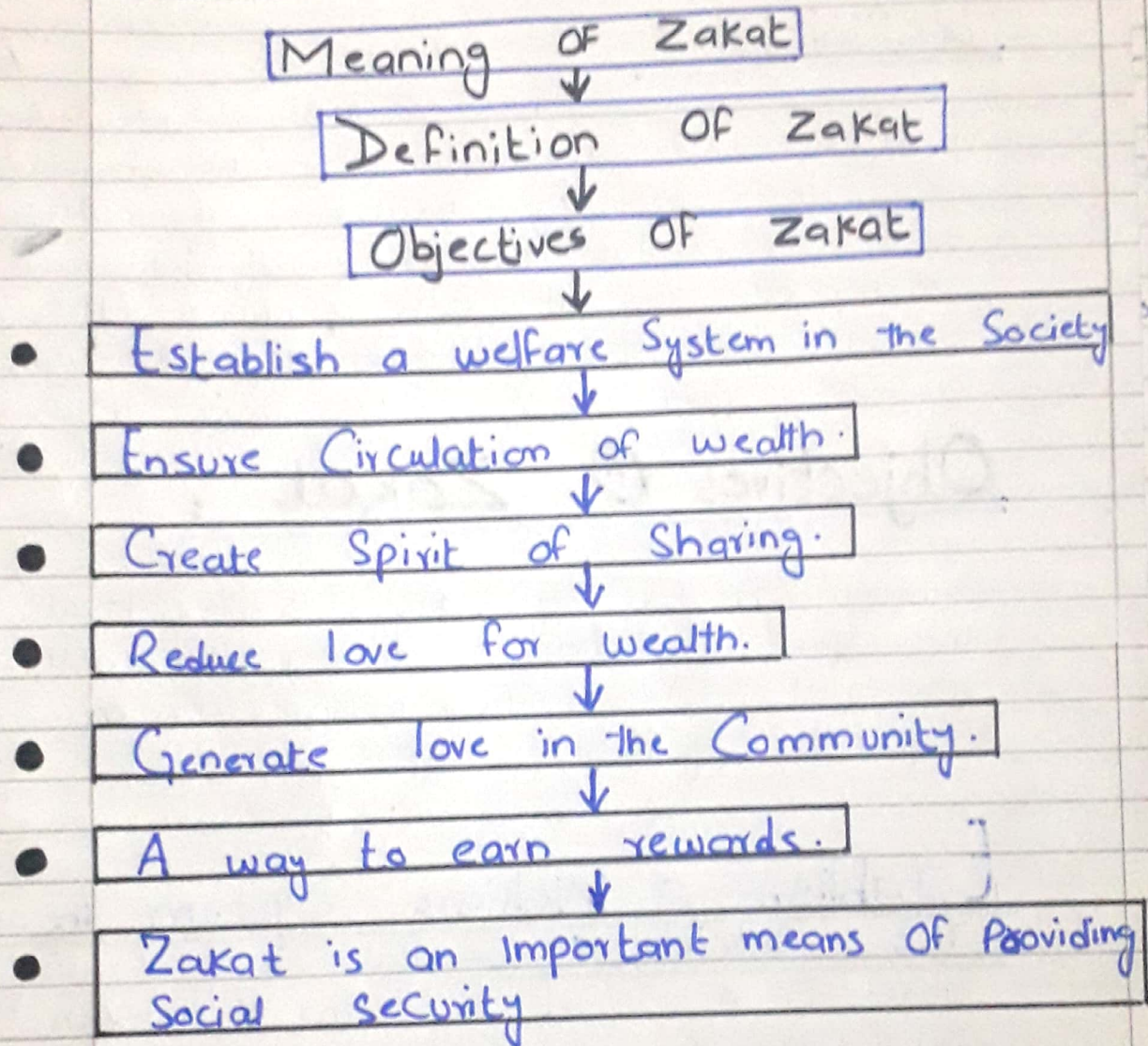

Definition :

The Zakat is a mean of Purification. It purifies the character of the wealthy individual from the stain of selfishness that, if left unchecked, and it also purifies the wealth by taking from it the right of the poor.

Objectives of Zakat :

The Primary Objective of Zakat is to elevate the spirit of human being above the material acquisition. The main Objectives of Zakat are ;

Establish a Welfare System in the Society :-

Zakat is the Third Pillar of Islam and it is an obligatory payment that a free and rational muslim who owns a certain amount of wealth has to observe. Its importance in Islam is manifested by the numerous pairings of its obligation to that of Prayer (Salah) in the Quran. Among the fundamentals of Islam, it has the most direct economic implications on muslim for it involves the

distribution of wealth from the affluent in Society to those in need.

Ensure Circulation of wealth:

Zakat is to eliminate Poverty in muslim Societies. As for its Collective Impact, It prevents hoarding of wealth, provides Social Security, Creates Social harmony and justice and helps in the Circulation of wealth from those well-endowed to the needy of Society.

Create Spirit of Sharing:-

The manifestation of Zakat is giving a fixed amount in alms annually, but the Spirit behind is the Service of mankind. A man who gives alms will develop a Zeal in himself to do good to the others. He would like to live a life which is most useful to the others.

Reduce love For wealth:

Zakat is Considered a way to purify one from selfishness and greed. By paying Zakat, we free our selves from the love of money. This way, the money does not get accumulated with the wealthy, and the poor receive their share. It helps in reducing Poverty.

Zakat purifies the giver of feelings like miserliness and selfishness, and generates the spirit of generosity and humanitarianism. It generates love in the Community.

Tawheed In Islam:

Tawhid is the most important Islamic belief.

It means the oneness or uniqueness of Allah. It is the indivisible oneness concept of monotheism in Islam.

It is the main part of Iman (faith). Tawhid is the religion's concept, upon which a muslim's entire faith rests.

The concept of tawhid is that God is one and unique, and that there is only one God, Allah to be worshipped and obeyed.
