Answer-

It is believed that Prophet Muhammad had received revelations from Allah for 23 years. At first, these revelations were preached by the prophet verbally.

The Quran is the Holy book of Islam. The Quran considered by Muslims to be "the word of Allah", this book is different from other religious texts in that it is believed to be the literal words of Allah through the prophet Muhammad. The Quran is used with the habit to interpret sharia law.

History-

Muslims believe the Quran was first revealed to Muhammad by the angel Gabriel in a cave on the mountain of Hira and then over a period of 23 years until his death.

Allah has mentioned the following four Holy books in the Holy Quran.

1) The Taurah:-

It is called old testament also. It was revealed to Hazrat Musa (p.b.u.h).

2) Zuboora

It was revealed to Dawud. (p.b.u.h)

3) The Injil:-

It was revealed to Hazrat Isa (p.b.u.h)

4) The Holy Quran:-

Revealed on our Holy prophet Hazrat Muhammad (SAW).

Write down the explanation of surah e Quraish!

Answer:-

TRANSLATION:-

For the accustomed security of the Qurash. their accustomed security to the journeys in the winter and the summer so they should be worship the lord of this house. (He) who his fed them against hunger and made them secure from fear.

Historical Background:-

- ★ This surah was revealed in Makkah.
- ★ Quraish is the name of an Arab tribe that used to be scattered across Arabia until a man named Qusayy gathered them together in Makkah and they eventually gained control of the Kaaba. He founded a city a state in Makkah and made

arrangements for pilgrimage to the Kaaba.

* While most Arabian tribes were constantly at battle with each other, the Quraysh had an advantage because they were the controllers of the Kaaba. As such, they were respected.

Explanation:-

This surah has four verses. Its title is taken from verse one. This surah was revealed in Mecca most probably during the early days of Muhammad's proclamation of his prophethood. The previous surah "Al Feel" are closely related that perhaps it was revealed immediately after "Al Feel". Some tradition state that some of the companions of the prophet regard the two surah as one entity.

Summary-

It urges the Quraysh who dominated Mecca to serve Allah, who had protected them. It is one of the two surah containing for four Ayats. The other is "al Ikhlas". The Kaaba was the central to the life of the Quraysh being the center of pilgrimage which brought much trade and prestige.

Question 1-03

According to Quran what is Tawheed and how to effect on human lives?

Answer 1- Definitions-

Tawheed means belief in the unity of Allah. The starting point of Islam is this belief in the unity of Allah. Tawheed is a revolutionary concept and constitutes the essence of the teachings of Islam. It means that there is only one supreme Allah of the universe. He is omnipresent, omnipotent and the sustainer of the world and mankind.

According to Quran:-

→ "Say" "He Allah is one. Allah is he on whom all depend. He begets not, nor is he begotten and none is like him."

→ There are a number of verses in the Quran which clearly explain the oneness of Allah. The Quran says.

Effect on Human Lives:-

→ Tawheed is a responsibility rather than a privilege. It encourages man to work transforming himself is accordance with God's revealed will. Tawhid creates in man a sense of responsibility in right person.

→ This belief produces in man the highest degree of self respect and self-esteemate. The believe knows that Allah alone is the possessor of all power. Provider of his needs gives and taken away life his conviction makes him indifferent to independent and fearless.

→ Islam connects As ethical monothesis to social-political and economic justice injustices. according to Islam. Lead to desruption of peace. they must be confronted and corrected. In reality Allah is himself Justice. ~~the following~~
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
