Q1:- What is the meaning of Zakat? -

### Meaning of Zakat:-

Payment made annually under Islamic law on certain kinds of property and used for charitable and religious purposes, one of the five pillars of Islam.

### Objective of Zakat:-

The basic objective of Zakat is to create balance in the society and never let poor and needy to suffer or die. The Zakat is compulsory when we have a specific amount of Gold, Silver or other properties that can be weighted and calculated.

- The objective of Zakat, as emphasised in the Qur'an, is a glorious objective of purification and upliftment (Surah Al-Tauba 9/103).

Q2:- Write prime categories of prayers?

## Prime Categories

- \* Fard prayer
- \* Sunnah prayer
- \* Wajib prayer
- \* Nafil prayer

1 Fard Prayer :- Fard prayers are compulsory for Muslims. If a fard prayer is missed for some reason, it should be made up later. The reward for praying fard prayers in congregation is more than for praying alone.

2 Wajeb Prayers : This is also an obligatory prayer. It has lesser importance than the fard prayer. The witr prayer (offered during the isha prayer) is a wajeb prayer.

3 Sunnah Prayer : It was the practice of the prophet Muhammad (pbuh). Allah did not command to perform

these prayers.

4 Nafil Prayer: Nafil prayers are optional or voluntary prayers. One can offer nafil prayers depending on one's will.

### Difference b/w nafil and wajib prayer

Nafil means voluntary act of worship. So the two in their common usage have generally the same meaning when they refer to acts of worship like prayer or fasting.

Wajib will tend to be used for things that are obligatory in the situation, but not at core. Some will also distinguish b/w the two based on strength of the evidence for it.

Ans :- Five Signs before the day of judgement.

- (1) Dajjal will come.
