Question No#2: Who is editor? Explain the role of editorial board. Answer No#2: **Editor:**

An editor is a person in newspaper agency, who has a responsibility to choose which news is going to publish in the newspaper at which place, and which fonts. Editor decides about all the news and commands reporters to report the news. Editor check for accuracy and fairness in the news if it fulfil his demands, he approves it for publishing. **Example:**

If there are 3 events that happened in Peshawar, which includes road accident, rape case, and sports opening ceremony where the guest was CM, the editor now will decide which news to keep on top, with which headlines. He will decide the space the room the length for the news. **Editorial board:**

They are the advisory board in the news agency, who decides about the news publishing, and about newspaper. They consist of a team, they act as ambassadors for the newspaper, the content and quality of newspaper is judged by their editorial board.

Role of editorial board:

- They bring new topics on the table, they work on special edition and give advices on how to implement new things in newspaper. They give feedback on the issues that were discussed before, they give suggestions to reporters and writers.
- They get big news from big agency, as small scale reporters don't have access to big authorities.
- They provide content by writing short articles.

- They have approaches to high authorities.
- They have good relation with contributors.
- They review the news and give opinions about it.
- They organise appropriate conferences for reporters and writers.
- They encourage the team, and make them work together.
- They have more knowledge about the subject area.
- They are seniors so they have more experience in all situations.

Editorial Staff:

- Chief editor.
- News editor.
- Deputy editor.
- Sub editor.
- Page in charge.

Chief editor:

Chief editor decides about news, what news to publish, what relationship to keep with which organisation and decide board meetings.

News editor:

Do what chief editor commands on, he works on all the news and tasks that is decided in the board meeting. All the news reports goes to him.

Deputy editor:

This scale was made now and it was not in back times, he helps the chief editor.

Sub editor:

He supports news editor, he bring news to news editor to publish on page 1 or 2. He bring all the important news. Every page have different sub editors.

Page in charge:

He don't depends on anyone, he design news himself, he picks all the extra news to bring them in use.

The important sources of news for the newspaper are the

following:

- Press note.
- Press release.
- Handouts.
- News Agencies.
- Police station.
- Fire brigade.
- Hospitals.
- Press statement.
- Press communique.
- Hotels.
- Institutions.
- ISPR.

Press Note:

Press note is an official news on account of any event that is sent by government. It is short and have a direct message. It includes what the PM or President has to say about any event, and there is no extra news. It is made in suitable words and acceptable manners.

Example:

Imran khan PM of Pakistan, addressing the nation about Novel corona virus, the announcement of ihsas program to the news agencies are press note. And it will be published as it is said.

Press release:

It is a short news story written to news agencies by public relation officer, PRO. The purpose of press release is to grab the attention of media towards that news and to publish it in the newspaper to inform others. **Example:**

When Imran khan was only the chairman of PTI, he used to send his news through his PRO to the news agencies for publishing.

Handouts:

It is free, it is distributed free to aware people, the only purpose is to distribute it as much as possible to aware people about that news.

Example:

Pamphlets of organisations, institutions or restaurants.

News Agencies:

They hire different people in news agencies from different countries, and then become the sources, they bring news to you and you pay them in return.

Example:

TNN, AFP, APP, APNS, UPI, SANA.

Police station:

All local police stations gives crime reports, or any reports that is reported in the area. They inform the media about crimes, records and any other sources they get.

Example:

Mumtaz Bangash from Mashriq give crime reports.

Fire brigade:

They are the eye witness of attacks or incidents, they are the first source of the news. They inform you about what they saw at first place.

Example;

Fire in Karkhano market Peshawar, the fire brigade informed the media about what was the causes, what are the loses, how many people have suffered.

Hospitals:

They inform about casualties in any accident, or blast, or any murder cases. They give information related to hospitals. How many people were killed in an attack, how many people were brought to the hospital etc. **Example:**

LRH and KTH, Police hospital, telling media about the cases of corona patients, about death casualties and number of patients.

Institutions:

Educational institutions giving briefing on how the system is running, what implementations are brought in education, what changes occur with system.

Example:

Boards directing media.

ISPR:

Arm forces giving media details about their actions against enemies and their targets and achievements.

Example:

Army Chief telling media about successful operation on loc.

Hotels:

Hotels at Northern areas telling about customers in winters and summers, they tell about how many people visits them.

Example:

PC in Malamjaba, Swat, telling media how many people visited in snow festival this winter.

Reporters:

Reporters are important factor for the newspaper, they feed the newspaper, they collect all the above news and bring to the news agency. There are different reporters for different beats, each reporter covers her own beat.

Reporters role in sources of news:

The following points are about the role of reporters in sources of news:

- They go to all the places included in their beat to take the news.
- They have good relations with authorities they are taking news from.
- They know the tactics of how to take out important news from their sources.

- A reporter has the courage and level of intelligence to work smoothly.
- They are expert in showing up emotions, they know what to speak when and how to control the situation.
- They have commands on media equipment's.
- They know to tolerate if other is not tolerating.
- They always finds a valid news.
- Reporters are good in communicating, they know how to communicate with public and authorities..
- They are punctual And they don't miss the opportunity by being late.
- They have a clear vision.
- They make quick decisions.
- They are organized.
- They have good dressing sense at different events.
- They keep good relations with everyone.
