\* 1st Phase 1947 to 1958 :-

After the Partition of India on the midnight of 14 and 15 August 1947 Pakistan followed the British system by creating the post of Prime Minister:

Based at the Prime Minister's Secretariat the Governor General of Pakistan Quaid-e-Azam Liqat Ali Khan appointed to establish and lead his administration on 15 August 1947. Before the presidential system in 1960, '7' prime ministers had served between 1947 until Marshal Law in 1958 by Ayub Khan.

Ans 1 :- Sir Syed Ahmed Khan :- 1817-1898

Sir Syed Ahmed Khan flourished from 1817-1898. As the founder of Aligarh Movement, he is ranked among the greatest Muslim reformers of the 19<sup>th</sup> century. He came to the rescue of his co-religionists after the war of Independence (1857).

- \* Sir Syed Ahmed Khan joined East India Company as a Record keeper, he rose to the position of chief Assessment official.
- \* During his employment at Bijnor, he saved the lives of British women and children at risk of his life.
- \* Great scholar and leader died on 27<sup>th</sup> March 1898 at Aligarh.
