As of 26th April 2020, there are 2.91 Million cases of COVID-19 reported in more than 185 countries and 203,000 deaths while 828,000 people have recovered.

Then in 1931 Arthur Schalk & M.C Hawn discovered the same disease in chickens in North Dakota. The Human COVID-19 was discovered in 1960s in the UK & USA. The symptoms of this virus were fever, dry cough, tiredness, sore throat, diarrhea, nasal congestion etc.

White to avoid getting infected it was suggested to isolate yourself and stay clean, wash hands, wear a mask, use hand sanitizer do steam breathing etc. So, because of the Historical Context of this virus was written, it was easier for the present generation to identify the disease, where and what are its symptoms, its precaution, treatment and cure.
