UNITORY STATE Government:-

A unitary state is one in which the supreme government authority is vested by the constitution in a single central government which rule the whole country for administrative convenience. The country is divided into various provinces, territories or departments, with their own local administrative bodies, but this level government exercise only such government power as is delegated to them. By the central government England, France, Italy, Iran, etc. are the examples of unitary state of government.
