Write down the explanation of Surah-e-Quraish?

Surah-e-Quraish :->

- (1) "Quraysh tribe" is the English name of Surah-e-Quraish.
- (2) Total verses : 4
- (3) Total words : 17
- Total letters : 77
- Chapter Number : 106

Translation :->

- (1) For the accustomed security of the Quraysh.
- (2) Their accustomed security to the journeys in the winter and the summer.
- (3) So they should worship the Lord of this House.
- (4) Who has fed them against hunger, and made them secure from fear.

Theme of Surah Quraish :-

In Surah Quraish, ALLAH reminds the Qurayshites of the grace He bestowed upon the land; safety, growing businesses, and the respect others gave them for living in ALLAH'S Sanctuary.

-: Explanation :-

This surah gives a brief account of God's Blessings on the tribe of Quraysh. It was the ruling tribe of Mecca. They were the custodians of the Kaaba, and their primary profession was trading, but the most significant gift was Kaaba, the house of the Lord. People from all over the world would come to visit it. Quraysh had a lot of respect, Prominence.

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Also it is a source of significant income through pilgrims. It has also been said that the meaning (الأيام) is what Quraish would gather during their winter & summer journeys to Yemen & Syria respectively and return to their city in safety due to the respect that the people had for them because they were the residents of ALLAH Sanctuary.

Life of Quraish :->

The Islamic prophet Muhammad (SAW) was born into the Hashemite clan of the tribe. The Quraish hejazi pronunciation are a mediantile Arab tribe that historically inhabited and controlled Mecca and its Kabba.

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According to Quran what is Tauheed and how to effect on Human lives?

← : TAUHEED : →

The doctrine of Unity or oneness of God is the pivot around which the whole system of islam revolves. It commands the Position of the Sun in the solar system

A Muslim believes firmly in the fact that ALLAH is one and only one, and he expresses this belief in words and actions. In case a person does not firmly believe in Tauheed, he has a basic defect in his faith of islam, which amounts to his belonging to the ranks of Non-muslims.

Importance of Tawheed :-

Tawheed or the oneness of God, is an important teaching with regards to beliefs about not worshipping idols.

Since they might believe so strongly in the oneness of God. They will also think that ALLAH is just and merciful so will allow all Muslims who have followed his ways to Jannah.

Tawheed of Quran :-

Some of the verses of the Holy Quran preaching the Creed of the oneness of ALLAH.

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In Surah Alkhas :- (

Translation . "say, He is ALLAH, the one

ALLAH the eternally Besought of all
He begetteth not nor was He begotten
And there is none Comparable into him

Humanity :-

The Conduct of a true
Muslim is regulated by his firm
belief in tawheed . He cultivates
humility and forbearance, since
he knows that he is helpless before
ALLAH whatever he possesses belong
to ALLAH .

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⇒ 86 Surah's are Meccan.

⇒ 28 are Medinan.

Verses :->

The number of verses in the Quran is 6,666. But there is opposition, \therefore in Muslim Scholars. Some Scholars said that the total number of verses in Quran is 6,236 excluding Bismillah and 6349 including Bismillah.

CHAPTERS :-

⇒ There are 30 chapters in Al-Quran

1 The first chapter (parah) name is (Surah Al-Baqarah)

The last chapter (parah) name is (Surah Amma)

Al-Quran :->

Al-quran is the holy book for Muslims. It is miraculous word of ALLAH revealed to prophet Muhammad through the angel jibreel. Therefore, Al-Quran is a wahy or divine revelation that has reached us through or a holy connection starting from ALLAH to the angel jibreel to the Prophet Muhammad. The wahy or Quranic

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Revelation is regarded by Muslims as the exact words of ALLAH. The revelation of Al-Quran started in the month of Ramadan during the year 610 AD at that time prophet Muhammad was in a cave called Ghar Hira on the Jabul-un-Noor or the mountain of light near Makkah jibrael an continued to teach Prophet Muhammad passages of Al-Quran every now and then.

Information - Structure of Al-Quran :-

(1) There are 538 Ruku's in the Holy Quran

(2) There are 114 Surahs in the Quran (Surahs divided into ayahs).

=> The shortest Surah of Al-Quran is (AL-Kawthar)

=> The longest Surah of Al-Quran is (AL-Baqara) and which contains 286 verses.

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- The Quran's is for all times, all conditions and all mankind :-

=> It contains a complete code which provides for all areas of life. It is a code which has no boundaries of time, place or nation. It will remain the same for all times to come as ALLAH has taken upon Himself the duty of guarding it.

=> In the Quran there are also reminders of ALLAH's favours on his creation, mild but firm warnings and rebukes. There are also stories of the past, followed by lessons to be learned from their fate.

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←: The theme of the Quran :->

The theme of the Quran consists broadly of three fundamental beliefs. They are:

- (1) Tawhid - ALLAH and predestination
- (2) Risalah - Angels of ALLAH, Books of ALLAH and Messengers of ALLAH
- (3) Akhirah - Life after Death and the Day of the Judgement.

Quran Actually wrote:-

According to Islamic tradition. The Quran was first compiled into a book format by Zayd ibn Thabit and other scribes under the first Caliph Abu-Bakr as Siddiq.
