It should be noted that it was forbidden to raise ones voice in the presence of prophet Muhammad (S.A.W) while he was living and it is forbidden to raise one's voice at the grave of the Holy Prophet (PBUH) in Madinah, now that he's dead.

Allah warns that one might lose all of his good deeds if he disrespects the Sunnah of his prophet or raise voice against him.
