ANSWER NO 2 : SIR SYED AND IDEOLOGICAL RATIONALE

SIR SYED AHMAD KHAN 1817-1898

Initially worked for East India company as a jurist

After the 1857 independence war, he published the causes of Indian mutiny (Risala asbab bhagawat e hind) a daring critique at the time

Founded Scientific Society of Aligarh denounced Congress for being pro-Hindu

And established Muslim League

Sir Syed was criticized by Ulema at the time for his approach towards religion .
