* Quran was revealed on 18th of Islamic month of Dhu-al-Hajjah in the year 10 AH (Feb-632).

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* No of Para's:

There are 30 Para's in Holy Book of Quran.

* No of Surah:

There are 114 Surah's (Chapters) in Holy Book of Quran.

* No of Ayats: (Verses):

There are 6,666 verses in Holy Book of Quran. In fact, the total number of verses in Quran is 6236 including Bismillah and 6349 including Bismillah.

Verses are the divisions of Surah's actually.

* Makki Surah's (Chapters):

They are 86 (eighty six) Makki
Surah's in Holy Book of

Why was Surah Quraysh revealed?

This ~~surah~~ Surah was revealed in Mecca most probably during the early days of

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Muhammad's proclamation of his prophethood further more, as per traditions, Umar bin al-Khattab had once recited the two surah's as one in the Prayer. This surah gives a brief account of God's blessings on the tribe of Quraysh where Muhammad was born.

According to Quran what is tauheed and how to effect on human lives?

Answer:

Tauheed:

The one-ness of God (Allah) is the pivot around which the whole system of islam revolves. It commands the position of Sun in the solar system. A muslim believes firmly in the fact that Allah is one and only one, and he expresses this belief in words and actions. In case a person does not

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does not firmly believe in Tauheed, he has a basic defect in his faith of Islam, which amounts to his belonging to ~~the~~ the ranks of non-muslims.

* All the religions of the world have always affirmed that Allah is one. Allah the wise men and great scholars of the world have had belief in the one-ness of Allah.

* The Book of Allah, the Holy Quran, has

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made the creed of
one-ness of Allah
indispensible for muslims. The
earlier Holy Books also
preached the unity of God,
but due to interpolations
made in the text of
the scriptures, and
inclusion of facts against
the principles of Tauheed
the Divine teachings were
changed. So, Allah sent
his Last Prophet Hazrat
Muhammad (S.A.W) to set
the people on the
right path & to bring
about reformation in their
creed.

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The Holy Quran preaches
the doctrine of tauheed
in very elegant form.

Allah says in Quran:
