Prayers are classified into categories based on degree of obligations. One Common Classification is fard ("Obligatory") & Wajib ("Compulsory"), and Sunnah ("Tradition") & Nafl ("Voluntary").

Difference Between Nafl and Wajib prayer:

Nafl Prayer or supererogatory prayer is a type of optional Muslim salah (Formal worship). As with Sunnah prayer, are not considered obligatory but are thought to confer extra benefit on the person performing them.

But

Wajib prayers are two types.

1. Festival Prayers (salat-al-Edain): The two yearly festival prayers consists of two Rakhas they are performed in congregation salat of Eid ul Fitr and salad of Eid Ul Adha.
2. Odd Number Prayer (Salat-al-Witer): It composed of three Rakhas it is performed Daily after the night prayer (Salah Isha) if one misses the odd number prayer it is also Wajib to make it up.
