Introduction :-

Quran is Islamic sacred book, the word of Allah, the ultimate knowledge, revealed on prophet Muhammad (P.B.U.H) around 600-623 AD, through archangel Jibreel. It is the most readable and recited book till today. The Quran is the primary source of Islamic jurisprudence and play an vital role in codification of Islamic laws. The revelation period of Islam started with the revelation of Quran's first Ayat, as I Q R A mean recite.

Quran is the core book of Islamic religion, as Christianity has bible and Judaism has Torah and Hinduism has Vedah. In Quran Allah describes as.

"Indeed we have sent down the reminder, and indeed we will preserve it." (Al Hajer, verse 9)

Synopsis of Quran:-

The brief synopsis of Quran is briefly explained below:-

- i) Chapters:- Chapters of Quran is divided into 30 sections in common language they are called paras. Some names of chapters are; ف^1 , سور , سور^4 in arabic these are called Juzz.
- ii) Surah:- Surah's are the topics of Quran. there are 114 Surahs of Quran. Quran's different topics and themes are described as per Surahs. The Surah's are further divided into madini and maki Surah's.
 - a) Madini Surah:- Surah revealed after Hijrat.
 - b) Surah maki:- Surah revealed before Hijrat, these Surah are short and brief as compare to madini Surahs. The Topics discuss in maki Surah are toheed, fariz and fundamentals.
- iii) Verses:- The revelation sentence is called verse. there are 6666 ayat in Quran.
- iv) Manzil:- Manzil are the divisions of Quran into 7 degrees.
- v) Tafseer:- Tafseer is the explanation of Quran.
- vi) Tarjium:- The translation of Quran is called Tarjium.
- vii) Source of enlightenment:- Quran is prime source of Islamic laws after with is Hadith and Sunnah.

Importance of Quran through verses:-

- i) This is the book about which there is no doubt, guidance for those conscious of Allah. (2:2)
- ii) And it was not possible for this Quran to be produced by other than Allah, but (it is) a confirmation of what was before it and a detail explanation of the former Scripture, about which there is no doubt, from the Lord of the world (10:37)

Importance of Quran in Hadees:-

- a). "One who is proficient in reciting the Quran is associated the Quranic, noble, pious angel scribes. As he who stammers when reciting the Quran and find it difficult for him, he will be granted a double reward." (Sahih Al-Bukhari)

On other Hadees prophet S.A.W says.

- "The One who was devoted to the Quran will be told (on the Day of resurrection) 'Recite (the Quran) and ascend in rank as you used to recite when you were in the world. Your rank will be at the last verse you recite.'"

(البقرة، المائدة، النجم، الزمر)

-: Interesting facts about Quran: (26)


Some of the interesting facts of Quran are;

- i) Surah Al tawbah start without Bismillah, all other starts with ~~sur~~ bismillah.
- ii) The shortest Surah is Al-Kosar.
- iii) The longest Surah is Al-baqra.

- v) Nisa speaks about women laws.
- vi) Though other Abrahamic book the Quran is the most intact book still.

- ix) Hazrat Abu bakr ordered the ~~copy~~ the Quran to be saved in a book form after Jang-e-
- x) Zaid bin Harbil was ~~one~~ one of the companions who ~~wrote~~ ^{recited} most of verses during prophet life.
- xi) Hazrat Usman bin Affan ~~wrote~~ ordered the first and final version of Quran which was then given to Bibi Hafsa (R.A).

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Q#2 write down explanation of Surah Quraish?

Translation of Surah Quraish:-

- i). For the accustomed security of the Quraish. (verse 1)
- ii) Their accustomed security to the journeys in the winter and the summer (verse 11)
- iii) So they should worship the Lord of this House. (verse 111)
- iv) He has fed them against hunger, and made them secure from fear. (verse iv).

Explanation of Surah:-

Quraish was the name of tribe of which prophet Muhammad (PBUH) belongs to. The sub tribe in Quraish was banu Hashim. There are 4 core things describe into Surah Quraish. Some of the brief explanation of these 4 is describe below; .

a) Importance and familiarity of Quraish tribe:-

Importance of Quraish tribe can be grapped from this Surah. Quraish was wealthy tribe in past and ~~to be~~ ^{were} caretaker of Kabbah. (House of Lord). They were Progeny of Hazrat Ibrahim and Hazrat Ismail.

b) Journey in winter and summer in Arab:-

Climate of Arab was extreme. The Arab people were accustomed to journeys but it was very hard to travel in deserts in cold as well as hot weather. Quraish traveled northward to Syria and Egypt in summer and toward Yemen in winter

c) Baith-i-Kabba. (House of the Lord). (3b)

Kabba was important place for the abrahamic religions. This sentence means that the Quraish have attained this blessing only by virtue of the house of Allah. There were 360 idols in Kabah, but in this verse Allah, almighty, orders to worship Allah the Lord of the House Kaba.

d) The Allah who feeds you

He is the one who feeds them not the others. So seek Rizq from Him not from anyone else. The scatter arab tribes were in hardship due to lack of food, so Allah told them to ask for food only from Allah.

Q#3 According to Quran what is Tawheed and how to effect human lives?

Introduction:-

Tawheed means Oneness of God. Tawheed is the ideology which focused on the dogma of one God i.e Allah. The deity is One only creator of Universe, he is the Care taker the Lord of all Universe and mankind, and he would reborn you after your death and will judge you on day of

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Judgment. He is the only creator of Heaven and Hell. He only in aloness created all the creatures in this universe from Angles to Humans from Jinnah to Iblees and we all have to return to him.

Tauheed is monotheistic concept of deity and religion. Every Sin is forgivable in Islam but except Shirk and disobedience of tauheed.

Tauheed in Quran:-

Some of the verse based on tauheed are mentions below;

a) "Your God is one God: There is no God ~~not~~ only He (Allah) the benefic the merciful. (البقرة)

b) Say he is Allah, the One, Allah the eternally he sought of all he begotten not was be-gotten and there is none comparable unto him. (سوره الاحد)

c) Allah is Creator of all things and He is Guardian over all things". (Al-Zumar 62).

Tauheed in Hadith:-

There is complete chapter of tauheed in Sahneem (Imam Bukhari, Imam Muslim). In almost all fundamental Hadith are about tauheed and oneness of Allah.

Tauheed in daily life :-

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Tauheed plays important role in life some are;

i) Believe in Oneness :-

Firm believe in oneness of God, Allah.

ii) Avoidness from Sins :-

Tauheed concept avoid you from sins.

iii) Believe in Day of Judgment :-

Tauheed concept enhance the believe in day of Judgment.

iv) Farness from Biddat :-

Tauheed concept aparts you from the biddat and false doings of religion.
