In respect of population Pakistan is - presently 7th most populous country of the world. it comes after China = 1.261 million.

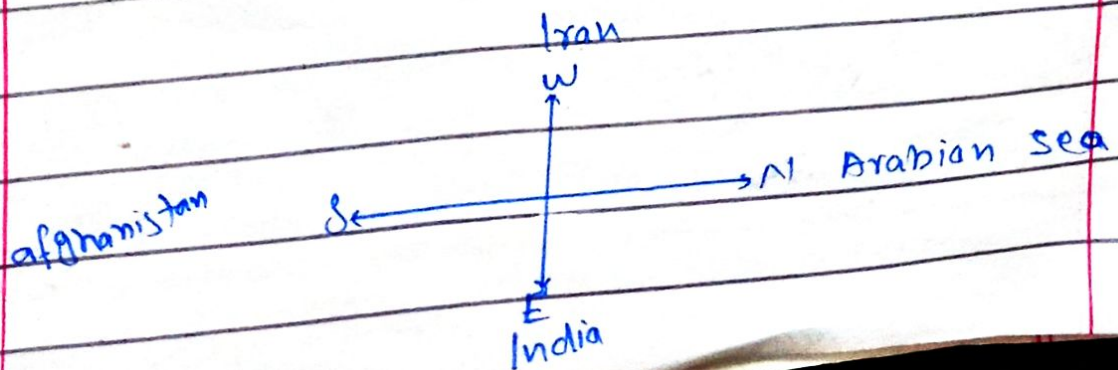

Discuss Sir Syed Ahmed Khan's educational and political services for the Muslims.

⇒ Sir Syed Ahmed Khan was born in Delhi in 1817 in a highly respectable family. He entered the Service of East India Company and rose to the position of Judge in 1846.

→ During 1857 he served with loyalty and distinction. He was appointed Chief Justice in Muradabad and was later transferred to Ghazipur. In 1864 he was transferred to Aligarh where he played an important part in establishing the College. Sir Syed was entrusted in Muslims. He wanted to improve relations with British →

and the positions of muslims. The central aims of the Aligarh movement were to improve relations b/w the british and muslims communities by removing british doubts about muslim loyalty and muslim doubts about the british ~~muslim~~ intentions.

Aligarh movement: Created a recognized identity of the indian muslims with the revival of the spirit of the ummah.

Aligarh became the symbol of muslim politics particularly after it was made the famous Aligarh muslim university. Undoubtedly Aligarh created a nation as it can not be denied that the Pakistan idea is the out come of Aligarh →

movement . improve the social
and economic position of
muslims by encouraging them
to receive western education
and take up posts in the
civil service and army.

increase their political awareness
to make them aware of
threat to the hindu Policy
of Cooperation with the british.
