Many leaders works hardly to make a constitution for this new country. But, for this purpose they had to make the country politically strong first of all.

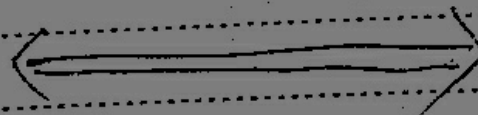
* They Appointed the first constituent assembly of Pakistan in 1947.

* But after many hard work and struggle 1st Constitution was made in 1958.

Q3: What do you know about the geography of Pakistan?

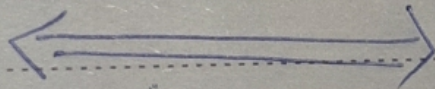
Ans: The Geography of Pakistan is a profound blend of landscapes varying from plains to deserts, forests, and plateaus ranging from the coastal areas of the Arabian Sea in the South to the mountains of the Karakoram, Hindu Kush, Himalayas ranges in the north. Pakistan geologically overlaps both with the Indian and the Eurasian tectonic plates where its Sindh and Punjab provinces lie on the north western corner of the Indian plate while Balochistan and most of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa lie within the Eurasian plate. At 881,913 square kilometers (340,509 sq. mi) Pakistan is the 33rd largest country by area.
