Article No 2: change of status of Jammu and Kashmir:

Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Act, 2019

⇒ Introduction:

On 5 August 2019, the Home Minister Amit Shah introduced the Jammu and Kashmir Reorganisation Bill, 2019, in the Rajya Sabha to convert, Jammu and Kashmir status of a state to two separate Union territories, namely Union Territory of Jammu and Kashmir and Union Territory of Ladakh.

The Union territory of Jammu and Kashmir was proposed to have a legislature under the bill whereas the Union territory of Ladakh is proposed to not have one.

⇒ Conclusion:

President Rule is not applicable to and is not needed in a union territory as the union territory anyway is controlled by the central government.

The president issued an order stating that he will rule the union territory of Jammu and Kashmir directly until the legislative assembly is constituted in the union territory.
