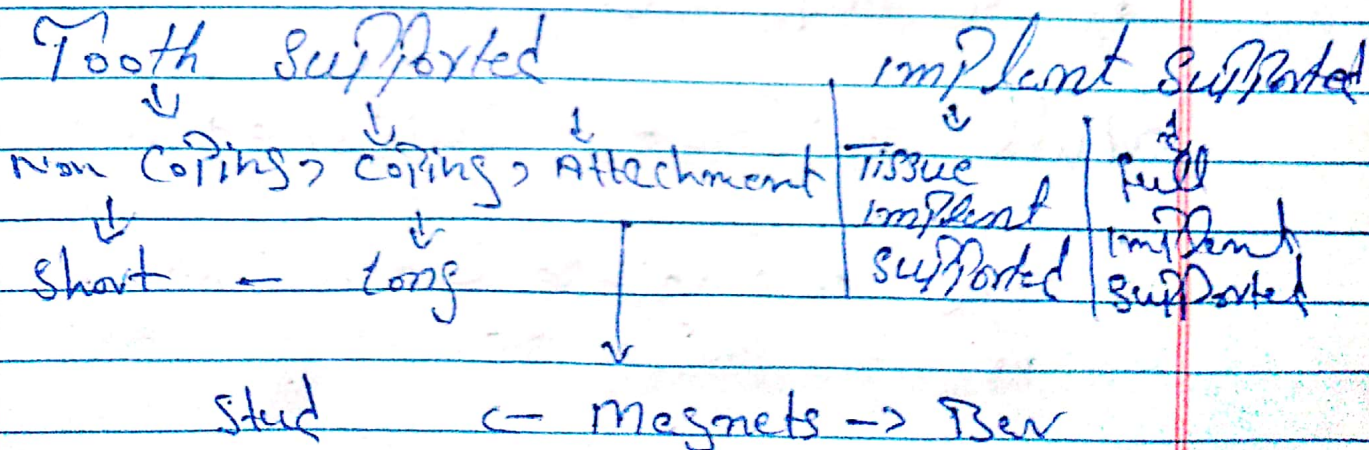

OVER Denture:

Introduction:

Extraction of teeth followed by continuous ridge resorption and poor denture foundation loss of periodontal receptors responsible for proper masticatory function and accurate jaw movements retention of few remaining teeth to support denture will preserve alveolar bone and preserve periodontal receptors.

Classification:



Types of Attachments:

① Rigid:

Doesn't allow movement of denture base. Provide adequate retention may induce more torque on abutment.

② Resilient:

Allows some control of movements, induces less torque on abutments.

⇒ Tissue implant supported:

In the mandible, a minimum of 2 implants

In the maxilla, a minimum of 4 implants.

⇒ Full implant supported:

In the mandible - a minimum of 4 implants.

In the maxilla - a minimum 4/6 implant

Advantages:

- Helps reduce shrinkage of surrounding bone.
- Reduce pressure to portions of the alveolar ridge.
- Positive Psychological advantage of still having teeth.
- Support - stability - Retention.
- Preservation of alveolar bone.
- Feels more like having teeth.
- more retentive in many cases.
- Patient acceptance.

Disadvantages:

- may cause attrition of teeth
- meticulous oral hygiene is required.
- Bony undercuts.
- Require special material and attach material
- caries susceptibility.
- more expensive.
