Concept of prophethood in Islam:

- prophethood is an essential need for people.
- The position of prophet cannot be acquired by effort, spiritual exercise or religious meditation.
- prophets were chosen by Allah.

→ In Arabic, ⁽⁴⁾ Rasul means one who is sent a message.

→ According to Ibn Taymiyyah, prophet is a man to whom God sends a message by means directly, or inspired by God.

→ Technically, both refers to a man chosen by God, who received message by means of divine Revelation, and to deliver it to a particular community.

→ In Islam, prophet hood has been given such a special status and significance, and it gives a great impact on man's life.
