- it has lesser importance than the Fard prayer.
- The witr prayer (offered during the Isha prayer) is a wajib prayer.

NAFL PRAYER:

- Nafl prayers are optional or voluntary prayers.
- one can offer Nafl prayers depending on one's will.

Q5, what is tawhid and prophethood in islam?

Answer :

TAWHID :

- The belief in the oneness and unity of Allah as expressed in the first of the Five pillars of Islam, the shahadah. Belief in this oneness or unity of ALLAH is an essential aspect of Islam.
- The Qur'an contains guidance for Muslims on the nature of Allah, and how to live a good life that pleases him.
- " Allah witnesses that there is no deity except him, and the angels and those of knowledge - maintaining the creation in justice. There is no deity except him, the exalted, in might, the wise"

PROPHETHOOD :

- Prophethood meaning Risalah or the belief in prophets, is a basic article of faith for Muslims.

- Prophets are messenger sent from God, or Allah, to help Muslims follow the straight path. Although the names of many prophets are recorded in both the Bible and the Quran. The Qur'an records the names of twenty-five prophets.
