Q1: what is meaning of Zakat?
and explain its objective?

introduction:

Zakat is a certain portion of the wealth and property that a muslim is obliged to pay yearly for the benefit of the poor and the muslim community. The payment of Zakat is obligatory, as it is one of the five pillars of Islam.

Meaning of Zakat :-

The word "Zakat" is an Arabic word that shows two literary meanings purification and growth

Purification :-

= it means the purification of soul, character, life and wealth. Zakat purifies the human soul by keeping a person from illegal sources of earning, eliminating the love for materialism and by overcoming the sense of pride for being wealth. wealth is dear to every one but who spend on other attains goodness and purity. As Quran says in sura al-Tubah:

" take alms out of their property. thou couldst cleanse them and purify them thereby.

Growth :-

It means that a person who pays Zakat regularly, his individual wealth as well as the community wealth keeps on growing by the blessing of the Almighty Allah.

Moreover Allah protects the wealth on which Zakat has been paid and in this way the peace of mind of the person who pays.

Objective of Zakat :-

The primary objective of Zakat is to elevate the spirit of human being above the material acquisition. Consequently, Islam does not view the Zakat payer as a mere of store of funds, but as

a person who always need purification and cleansing, both spiritually and materially. The prophet summarise this purpose in the ayat "Sadaqa from their wealth by which you might purify and cleanse them.

Besides that, Zakat trains people to acquire divine characteristic. if man purified of miserliness and greed and becoming accustomed to the habit of giving and spending, his soul is elevated above low human trait of covetousness." truly man is niggardly! and aspire to the height of divin perfection, since one the characteristic of Allah is absolute and unlimited mercy, powers, theoretical and practical. Allah obliges Zakat in order to perfect human

The prophet says, trains yourselves to attributes of Allah. the encouragement to spend through zakat and voluntary charity resulted with time in emergence of charitable trust all over muslim world, trusted devoted not only to helping the poor and needy but to all causes for human being as well as Animals.

Zakat also stimulates personality growth in those who pay it.

Through helping others overcome their financial difficulties, zakat payer's self to other and grow through helping them and gives the payer a noble sense of victory over his base desire and material drives over his own shaytan.

Ans: Prayer:

Prayer is religious service especially a regular one at which people gather in order to pray together.

Prayer (Salah) is the pillar of Islam it is prescribed liturgy performed five time a day and oriented toward Mecca.

Fard Prayer:

- * Fard prayers are compulsory for muslims
- * If a fard is missed for some reason, it should be make up latter.
- * The reward for praying fard prayer in congregation is more then for praying alone.

Summah prayer:

wajib prayer:

Nafil prayer:

- ① Nafil prayer are optional or voluntary prayers.
- ② one can offer nafil prayers depending on one will.

(2) difference between nafl and wajib prayer

wajib prayer

- ① This prayer is an obligatory prayer.
- ② it has lesser importance than the fard prayer.
- ③ The witr prayer (offered during the isha prayer) is a wajib prayer.

nafl prayer

- This prayer are optional prayer or voluntary prayers.
- one can fill offer nafl prayer depending on one's will.

Ans: Hajj :-

Hajj is the fifth basic duty of Islam.

Hajj is a visit to the Kabah in Makkah during the 12th Month of Islamic calendar - Dhul Hajjah. Hajj is an act of worship to please Allah. A Muslim tries to make pilgrimage at least once in a life time.

Benefits of Hajj

① Truthfulness:

"O you who believe! keep your duty to Allah and speak straight, true words. O you who believe. keep your duty to Allah and be with truthful people"

Be maintainers of Justice and bearers of true witness for Allah, even if it goes against your own selves or partner or someone who is rich or poor.

Honesty :-

Don't go near the property of an orphan, except in goodly way till he attain maturity. And fulfill the promise. Give full measure when you measure out and weight with true balance.

Do not swallow up your property among yourselves by false means, nor offer it as bribe to the officials so that you may swallow up other people property unlawfully while you know

Justice and tolerance:-

Glad Tidings on showing kindness to orphan
Rights of slaves
killing any one unjustly
is forbidden

(2) Purity and cleanliness

He indeed is successful who purifies himself and remembers the name of Lord. Then prays.

Purify your garments and shun uncleanness.

Q5: What is tawhid and prophet hood in Islam?

Ans: Tawhid:
